Keynotes for Humanity - How to Play

- 1. Remove the white "answer" cards from the envelope, leaving the black "question" cards in the envelope.
- 2. Pass out the white answer cards equally among all players.
- 3. Each player fills out all of their white answer cards with either a noun, a gerund, or a short phrase containing both. They may be related to education or not; it's probably in your best interest to make them laughably unique, although uplifting and inspiring options may play in your favor.
- 4. The person with the most vowels in their name is the first "Keynote Speaker." They reach into the envelope and select one black question card at random and reads it to the other players.
- 5. Each player places one white answer card face down in the middle of the table that they feel creates a compelling answer for the question.
- 6. The Keynote Speaker collects all of the cards, and reads through all of the answers in an authoritatively impressive voice befitting the introduction of a keynote talk.
- 7. The Keynote Speaker then selects their favorite response, and the person who submitted that white answer card receives the black question card as one "Inspiration Point"
- 8. Play continues clockwise, with the person to the immediate left of the Keynote Speaker becoming the new Keynote Speaker for the next round.
- 9. Once all of the white answer cards have been used up, the game is over, and everyone tallies their Inspiration Points. The player with the most points is the "Best Keynote Speaker in The World!"

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
